Navigator Program

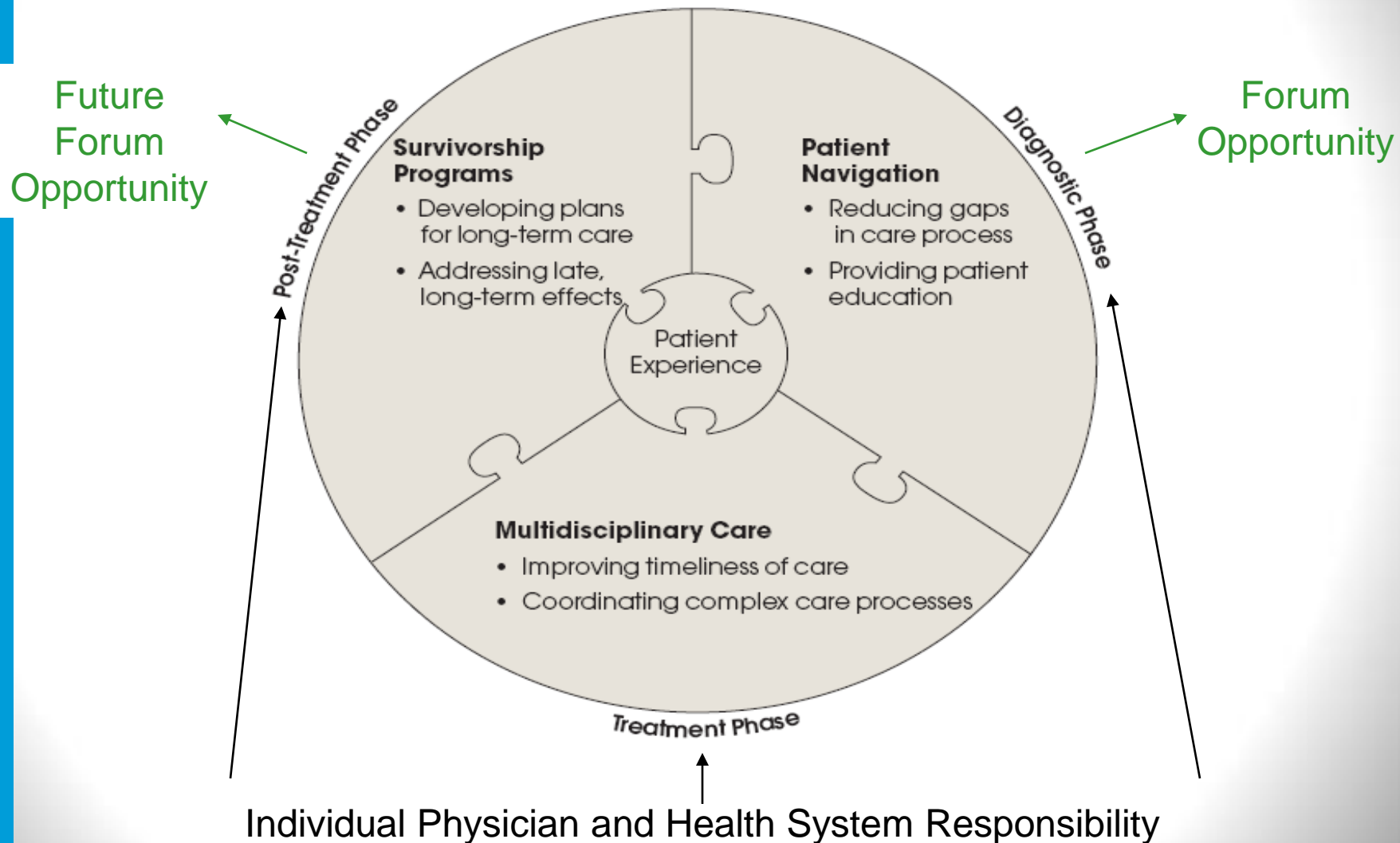
Purpose of the Navigator Program

- Ensure patients and families have full access to information and resources to support their successful treatment
- Treat the man and his family as well as the disease

Key Issues

- Identify prospective patients through community screenings and ensure they receive appropriate and timely follow-up care
- Serve as a guide to patients and their families through the provision of up-to-date information about community resources, treatment options, etc.
- Have a full understanding of the disease process and serve as a point of reference for the patient and his family
- Ease conversation around the key implications of prostate cancer including incontinence and sexual function

What makes this program different?

Health System Navigator Program

- Facility specific
- Care coordination
 - Assesses pt. needs
 - Manages pt. appts
 - Coordinates with hospital
 - Coordinates with MD
- Provides patient / community education, generally fairly facility specific
- Participates in facility sponsored screening activities

HR Prostate Forum Navigator Program

- Unbiased perspective
- Facilitator not provider
- Generic education
 - Equip patients with lists of community resources and questions to ask their doctor
- Forum representative at a variety of events by organizations including health systems and community organizations.
